

## Holdings File Content Field

B – Baptism or Birth. In the case of vital records, it's usually a birth but for sacramental records it'll be a baptism. Usually other information is included in the record itself, such as parents.

M – Marriage.

S – Burial (Sepulture) and deaths. If it's a vital record it will be a death, but a sacramental record will most always be a burial. Usually other information is in the record itself such as age, cause of death, and parents/spouse.

C – Census records, city directories, Passenger lists and parishioners lists. Typically a name and location. Census records often have an age.

I – Funeral home and cemetery records. Depending on the record there could be a great deal of additional information.

E – Military records including enlistments, muster rolls, and pensions.

O – Obituaries.

F – Family Genealogy, Family History .

Blank – None of the above apply.
